
Add Revenue Recognition Credits Customization

A CASE STUDY IN UTILIZING THE INFINITY SDK

Business Problem

Adding revenue recognition credit for past donations is labor intensive, as a recognition credit must be manually added for each revenue application.


The need to add credits for past giving occurs when adding new spouse, family foundation or privately owned business records.







High-Level Requirements

- As a user I am able to add missing recognition credits to a revenue recognition default recipient's record en masse.
- As a user I am able to specify the source and recipient constituents, and the gifts to credit based on gift date, transaction type, and site.
- As a user I am able to specify the recognition type and match factor for the recognition credits added (default values based on revenue recognition default).
- Only a single user can add recognition credits at a time for a given revenue recognition default.



Design Process


- Initially considered using a UI Model Add form
- Collection object presents some UX challenges







- As an admin I can view/download any spec that has been loaded to the database
- As an admin I can unload any spec that has been loaded to the database (with some exceptions)

Catalog Browser Enhancement

Key elements

- The Data List selects from all the individual catalog tables
- View XML and Unload Spec actions require a spec type enumeration found in Blackbaud.AppFx.XmlTypes.CatalogItemType
- The Unload Spec Record Operation calls the Blackbaud CLR stored procedure USP_UNLOADSPEC
 USP_UNLOADSPEC is the sproc called by the UnloadSpec method in the SpecLoader class contained in the Blackbaud.AppFx.SpecHelpers assembly, which is called by LoadSpec.exe

Things to note

- Some specs like batch extensions take too long to unload and timeout. I chose not to increase the timeout, since these can take hours.
- USP_UNLOADSPEC does not currently support unloading Query View Extension specs
- The spec types that are not included yet in my code are:

TableSpecExtension

CustomUIModelMetadata

WorkflowInboxSpec

WebPageModelSpec



Things to note

SystemPrivilege does not store the XML spec in the catalog table, so the View XML action is disabled

Problem: Easy Data Access


- Make access to data easy but flexible.
- Replace list-based export 'reports' with in-client presented lists.
- Deliver quickly without adding the feeling of clutter to CRM.
- Design keeping in mind future CRM growth and vision.

Solution: Foundation Hub


- Start with list builders but allow for future BI/report options:
 - Familiar functionality.
 - Flexible sort, filter, column preferences, export.
- Gain adoption across business units by diversifying list types:
 - Funds; Events; Interactions; Communications; Assigned Prospects; Plans.
- Implement as new functional area:
 - Functional area effectively is a page spec.
 - Functional area task performs 'ShowPage' where header attribute IsFunctionalAreaDefault="true"
- Intent to reduce functional areas over time in order to lessen the feeling of clutter.





Learned During Process

- List builders tend to run slower than data lists.
- List builders appear to run SQL twice.
- Top level filter will clear non-dependent parameters in dependent sections.
- Ideally the final design will move away from a hub and largely transfer what are tabs
 in the Hub to replace the existing CRM functional areas.




Reception

- Feedback has been extremely positive.
- Admins and managers appreciate the context-less view.
- Users appreciate embedded actions.
- New field requests common.
- New tab requests on occasion.




- Simplify navigation by removing/tidying functional areas.
- Redesign to follow a similar layout to the Foundation Hub.
- Start with Administration.
 - Least impact to users.
 - Least resistance from users.
 - Prep and tidy other areas by moving configuration and reference data tasks to Administration.


Layout: Administration Functional Area

Reception & Learned

- Users have adopted Administration without reports of confusion.
- Layout has made finding locations for update easier for admin team.
- New quality feature has varying degree of adoption throughout Foundations.

- As new features are added to DREAM, continued upkeep to ensure configuration and reference data links are added to Administration and not other functional areas.
- Already some new features that were introduced to DREAM without this consideration, leading to discrepancy in approach.
